Our Curriculum

Our Curriculum is rich and diverse seeking to motivate and engage students in learning, so that each individual can realise personal success. We offer three differentiated programmes to cater for a variety of student needs.

1. The 'Early Intervention' Programme – Years 7 & 8

Is a bespoke programme we can offer schools to work one day a week with a group of ten KS3 Year 7/8 students per academic term who are experiencing difficulty with transition and engaging fully with their mainstream offer. The curriculum can be tailored to the outcome needs of the school/group of schools, and the young people's needs.

2. Our 'Short Term Exclusion' Offer – All Years

Is our educational provision for young people on short-term exclusions or for those pending permanent exclusion. Short-term exclusion students will be separated from our 'Core Programme' cohort in the 'Short Term Learning Zone' where they will be supported in completing appropriately levelled work/coursework; given tailored mentoring to tackle behaviour and habits that have led to an exclusion, and if requested, students can undertake a bespoke 'Community Service'. The school will be furnished with a daily report. This service is specifically tailored to cater for schools wishing to offer off-site short-term provision. Full Circle has the capacity to take Short Term exclusion students for any period of time required and can create a bespoke offer.

3. Our 'Core' Programme – Years 9/10/11

AQA Unit Awards; The Duke of Edinburgh Award Scheme; BKS B Literacy and Numeracy Accreditation, Functional Skills, ICT, Vocational qualifications, Work Experience and a wide variety of nationally accredited sports and outdoor education qualifications underpin our offer to students joining our permanent core programme (3 or 4 days per week) alongside opportunities for some students to continue with their GCSE courses.

We are looking to offer a BTEC in Sport and other qualifications in the forthcoming year. We currently have capacity for 30 Students.

What is our offer to schools & Young People?

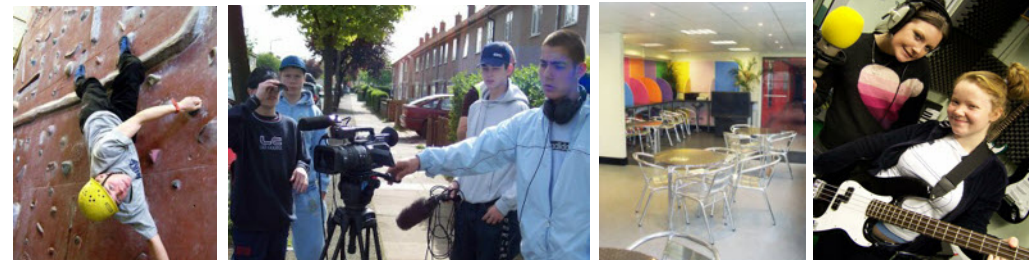
Our client group is young people who:
